Rooney double edges AC Milan at San Siro

CHAMPIONS LEAGUE: Man Utd wins 3-2

MILAN — David Beckham's first appearance against former club Manchester United was as topsy-turvy as his Old Trafford career after the midfielder started well before watching the English champion seize a 3-2 win at AC Milan.

Beckham, on loan at Milan from Los Angeles Galaxy, started the Champions League first knockout round, first leg at the San Siro and was soon in the action when his free kick led to Ronaldinho grabbing a third-minute opener.

His influence began to wane, however, and he was taken off after 72 minutes with the score at 2-1 to United thanks to a Paul Scholes fluke and a Wayne Rooney header.

Rooney added a second goal with his head two minutes after the substitution before Clarence Seedorf, who had replaced Beckham, pulled a goal back for the unlucky hosts in the 85th.

"I enjoyed it. The (United) fans were great to me. It's always great to play in front of a full house here," the England midfielder said after hearing United

fans sing "There's only one David Beckham" when he went off.

In Tuesday's other game, Jean Makoun scored in the 47th minute to give Lyon a 1-0 victory over Real Madrid.

Everton's edge


